Scope of processing

- Categories of personal data which are processed:

Our external service provider for the payment processing BS PAYONE GmbH, Lyoner Straße 9, D-60528 Frankfurt/Main always saves and processes only those personal data which are necessary to carry out the respective service. Depending on the type of payment, especially the IBAN, card number, check digit and the other transaction data (e.g. date/time of the transaction, payment amount) are processed in case of a payment processing. The fraud prevention also primarily takes place on the basis of the transaction data processed. For the receivables management, details as for example the information on the invoice/payment amount, the due date and the invoice recipient are processed. The credit assessment takes place e.g. based on the address, the account and the card data which are transmitted to the credit agency engaged for this purpose. Details as for example information on the invoice recipient, the bank details and the payment amount are necessary to issue the invoice. In case of a subscription processing, the contract term and the agreed settlement cycles are required besides the information on the invoice recipient and the payment amount. The aggregate micromanagement makes the processing of data necessary as e.g. for the settlement period, the number of transactions, the invoice recipient and the bank details/card number.

- Purposes for which the personal data shall be processed :

The data processing regarding the handling of payments takes place for the processing of the concluded purchase contract. The processing of your data is necessary according to art. 6, par. 1 lit. b) DSGVO for the performance of the contract.

BS PAYONE saves and processes personal data as long as this is necessary for the performance of the contract and the fulfilment of its contractual and legal obligations. If a saving of the data is not necessary anymore for the fulfilment of the contractual or special legal obligations and the purpose of storage does not apply anymore, personal data is deleted - except its further processing is necessary for the following purposes:
 - Fulfilment of retention duties according to commercial and contractual law and other retention obligations (e.g. the retention of booking relevant data for 10 years);
 - Conservation of evidences in the scope of the legal regulations on the limitation periods.

Rights of the affected persons

- You have the right according to art. 7, par. 3 GDPR to **revoke** your consent given to us anytime. The consequence is that we are not allowed to process data based on this consent in the future.
- You have the right to **information** on the collection and processing of your personal data according to art. 15 GDPR.
- You have the right to **correction** of incorrect personal data or the completion of personal data which we have stored according to art. 16 GDPR.
- You have the right to demand the **deletion** of the personal data which we have stored according to art. 17 GDPR if not otherwise required due to other reasons as e.g. the fulfilment of a legal obligation or the defence of legal claims.
- You have the right to a **limitation** of processing of your personal data according to art. 18 GDPR.
If your personal data are processed based on art. 6, par. 1, lit. e or f GDPR, you have the right to **object** the processing of your personal data according to art. 21 GDPR if not otherwise required for reasons which result from your special situation.
